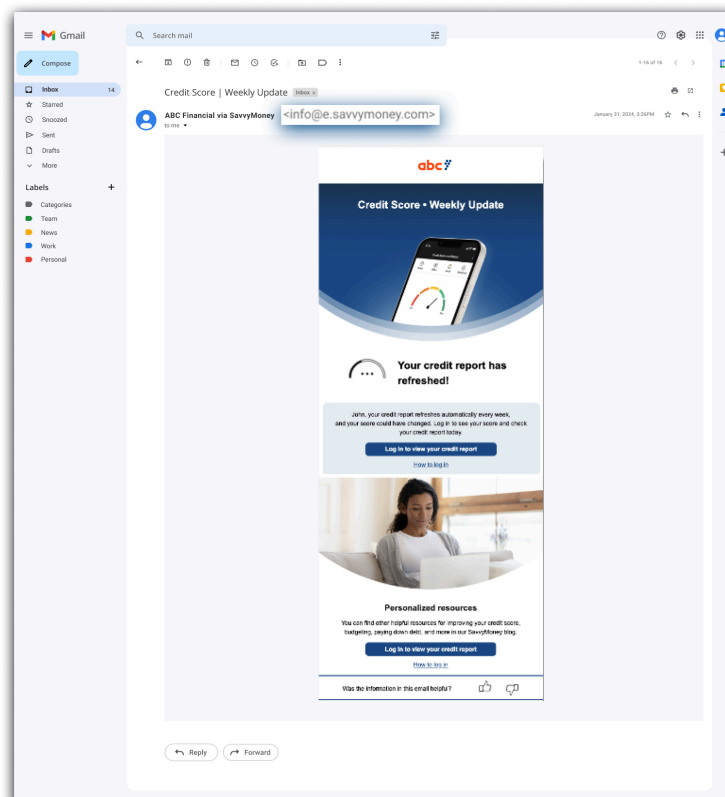

We would like to inform you about the measures SavvyMoney is implementing to align with the new SPF, DKIM and DMARC policies established by Gmail and Yahoo, scheduled to take effect on February 29, 2024.

We have modified our email address to improve the deliverability of our communications to end users. The updated email now features “e.savvymoney” at the end of the signature, ensuring that all end users receive pertinent communication, including Credit Monitoring alerts, New Inquiries, and updates. This adjustment is in line with a common practice observed among large corporations that send a substantial volume of emails, exceeding 5,000.
